

## CONSERVATION AREA

Compared to the densely built housing typical of the late 19th and early 20th centuries surrounding it, Selly Park is an area of spacious plots and generously proportioned architect-designed residential properties, open space and secluded culs de sac. It is a pocket of leafy suburbia close to Birmingham City Centre. The religious and educational establishments of St. Paul's RC Convent, Chapel and associated buildings, St. Edward's RC Church, Presbytery and School, and St. Stephen's Church and Hall are all situated within the conservation area.
