A seizure authority may, if satisfied that it is necessary to do so, destroy or dispose of any seized property where a claimant has not been notified of the seizure within the prescribed period. (a) the claimant has not been notified of the seizure within the prescribed period; (b) a claimant has been notified of the seizure but has not claimed the property within the prescribed period.

A copy of this notice has been published in the Birmingham Evening Post and other newspapers, and a copy has been placed in the vehicle, the registered keeper and any other person who is in possession, or has been in possession, of the vehicle.
