

A Public Space Protection Order is now in force in your area

A Public Space Protection Order is now in place in Bankside. This Order is in force from 20 January 2017. The following prohibitions will be enforced within the public spaces shown on the map:

1. Groups of three or more people engaging in activities which are likely to cause nuisance, annoyance, harassment, alarm or distress. Including, but not limited to verbal abuse, damage or vandalism, littering drug or alcohol related activity, violence or threat of violence.
2. Having in possession open cans, bottles or other unsealed containers containing alcohol.
3. Ingesting, inhaling, injecting, smoking or possessing intoxicating substances.
4. Having in possession a dog without a lead or not under control.

The order will be in force for a period of 12 months and will expire on 16 January 2020.

Penalty on breach

It is an offence to engage in any activity that you are prohibited from doing by this Order.

Depending on the behaviour in question,

the penalty may be a fine of up to £1,000 or a maximum of 3 months imprisonment or both.
