

# Community Infrastructure Levy Report 2015/16

## **Background**

1. Birmingham City Council's Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) charges took effect on 4 January 2016. The council is both a charging and collecting authority. Regulation 62 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010 (as amended) requires CIL charging authorities to produce an annual report detailing CIL income and expenditure. This is the first CIL annual report and covers the period from adoption of CIL to 31 March 2016 (financial year 2015/16).

## **Allocation of CIL**

2. CIL income is required to be allocated as follows:
- Up to 5% of CIL can be applied towards its implementation and ongoing administration
  - 15% (25% in areas that have a Neighbourhood Development Plan in place) of CIL is passed to the neighbourhood in which the development that paid the CIL is located for the provision of
