Vehicle release/recovery restrictions apply. Any claim for release must be made within 15 working days of the date of seizure.

The Authority may be of the opinion that it is necessary to retain the seized property for the duration of an investigation. A seizure authority may be exercised where a claimant has been notified of the seizure and the claimant has not made a claim within the prescribed period.

A copy of this notice has been placed on the vehicle, the registered keeper and any other persons who are entitled to possession, and in the case of a vehicle, the registered keeper and any other persons who are entitled to possession, and has been published on the Authority's website.

Proof of identity for the registered keeper and other legal structure

Where necessary, the registered keeper must provide proof of name and address for the vehicle. Any claim made without the necessary proofs described above will be treated as invalid.

ADVISORY NOTE: In compliance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1988, any vehicle found on a public road without valid insurance to drive (any vehicle) will be liable to seizure under the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
